The SBRC is offering 280 Scottish organisations a free Cyber Essentials pre-assessment gap analysis, which will be delivered through its network of trusted partners.

The [National Cyber Security Centre \(NCSC\)](#) has recorded 2.7 million cases of cyber fraud in the UK over 2021-22, and the SBRC says: "Organisations must be on the front foot when it comes to their cyber resilience in 2023."
