What is a vCISO?

A Virtual Chief Information Security Officer (vCISO) focuses on providing leadership, strategic direction, governance and compliance, to give an informed view of any information security risk being carried, and help to define a strategy and roadmap aligned to an organisation's risk appetite and proportionate to their needs.

As information and cyber security threats increase alongside heightened regulatory compliance, it's never been more important to gain greater insight of risks and threats. In doing so, and with risk exposure understood, companies should develop information security controls accordingly, enabling controls to be monitored, continuous effectiveness, and remaining proportionate to new and prevailing risks.

Implementation and management of controls can be complex and requires expertise and guidance to get to the right place and stay there.
